

## Classifications

One Nation team classifications are designed to put teams and players in position to compete at a fair level of play based on their current skill level and age group.

### Age Groups:

Youth Age Groups 7u,8u,9u,10u,11u,12u,13u,14u

High School Age Groups 15u,16u,17u,18u

### Divisions:

#### Hometown Division: (Rec/League)

Community based teams where players are from the local community. This division will consist of local travel teams, all-star teams, and recreation teams. Rosters may include two players from outside of city limits, as long as they are classified at the same level of play, to participate in this Division. No player who plays at the higher Division will be eligible to play in the Hometown Division.

#### Travel Ball Division: (Upper = AAA & Lower = AA)

Tournament Travel teams will be a part of this division. They will be ranked either in the upper level or lower level of this division. All local travel teams and lower-level club teams will be a part of the travel ball division. The Travel Ball Division will be where the majority of teams compete, as many player's skill level will fall into this category.

#### Elite Division: (Top Level)

Top level teams with rosters consisting of the highest-level athletes. Only teams that have been highly ranked will qualify to play at this level. This division is intended for the best of the best. Teams will not be accepted to this division unless approved by the board.

One Nation Baseball's governing body of team and player classifications, under the oversight of the Player Classification Committee (PCC), holds the right to reclassify any One Nation team or player under the bylaws, safety, and integrity of One Nation Baseball.
