Subject: Proposition 65

To Whom It May Concern:

This declaration serves as documentation in response to the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 (Proposition 65) and all its subsequent updates. The lists of chemicals known to the state of California to cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm is updated annually and available from the Office of Environmental Health and Hazard Assessment (OEHHA). This declaration is valid for the list of chemicals compiled by OEHHA current as of the signature date.

Even though on February 21, 2003, and on September 2, 2011, the state of California listed carbon black and titanium dioxide respectively as carcinogens under Proposition 65, the listing only pertains to airborne, unbound carbon black and titanium dioxide particles of respirable size; for the purposes of Proposition 65, particles 10 um or less shall be considered respirable. Exposure to carbon black and titanium dioxide, per se, does not occur when it remains bound within a product matrix, such as rubber, ink, or paint.

We declare that products manufactured by Precision Brush, when properly used, do not contain significant amounts of any chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm as of the date of this document.
