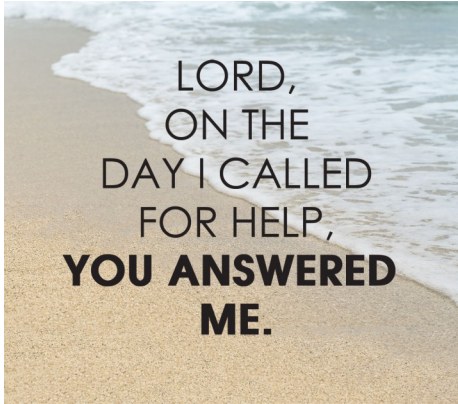

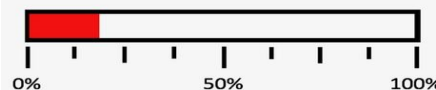

Our parish summer activity is both spiritual and physical. Our church and school buildings are where ministry happens, and the buildings suffered through a winter of freeze/thaw cycles. The masonry restoration required this summer exceeds anything I anticipated. Next summer, we must plan on addressing masonry restoration to the church towers. (Yes, we plan ahead!)

Last weekend, I invited you to join me in a special gift to our Capital Improvement Fund during the remaining summer months. I will gift the Fund \$300.00. May I ask you to consider what you might contribute over and above your current giving to the parish? Capital Improvement Funds are not taxed by the diocese. Every hard-earned dollar remains here at the Church of Saint Clare.

## **FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK**

***My pulpit remarks last weekend ...***

### **Your Parish Rocks!**

**That was the title of an email I received last week from Catholic Charities --- thanking the 499 parishioners who pledged \$131,250 to the 2019 annual appeal. That would be 124% of parish goal. Bishop Perez followed up with his own thank-you letter. Our generous response was made by long-term donors AND first-time donors—parishioners new to the parish or to the work force. If Charities has your email, you may have already received a message. If not, please accept my remarks as Charities' thanks and mine. Well done! What do you say to 500 donors next year!**

**I wish to acknowledge, as well, those of you who have or will make a summer contribution to the Capital Improvement Fund. DeNigris Concrete replaced the concrete pad and enlarged the drain line at the Saint Clare Statue school entrance. Masonry Restoration Maintenance has pointed deteriorated mortar joints at the north and south school entrances and walls. Same goes for the triple Mayfield Road church entrances. Masonry Restoration Maintenance will return to restore the Mayfield Road church steps in September. All of the existing caulking will be replaced. Four of the most severely damaged flat stone will be replaced while several others will be reset. Several of you have asked if you can have the old stone. Sorry---the masons have already claimed them!**

**A breakdown of our summer projects may be found in the bulletin today. What you will not find is the replacement cost for the AC unit in the Adoration Chapel which is in the neighborhood of \$3,100 dollars. (Just zeros! Zeros keep me awake far too many nights.)**

**Dear parishioners, in the words of Saint Paul: *You are no longer strangers and sojourners but you are fellow citizens with the holy ones and members of the household of God, built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the capstone. Through him the whole structure is held together and grows into a temple sacred in the Lord; in him you are also being built together into a dwelling place of God in the Spirit. (Ephesians 2: 19 – 22)***

**Friends, in an upper room on Pentecost, a spark once turned into a flame, and a flame grew into a fire that burns to this very day. If we are on fire, it is surely because of you! You did not simply drive onto a campus today--you entered holy ground. When ... Together at Table we restored this sanctuary and expanded the gym kitchen--the twin tables where we gather – Bishop Gries blessed them both. When we inaugurated Corpus Christi Academy, students did not simply walk into school on the first day, they processed – a piper in the lead – students following Bishop Gries. Capital Improvement is not about brick and mortar. We are living stones with Jesus as our capstone. Praise Him and give Him honor with time, talent and treasure.**

**Lastly, Father Cosgrove and I have set aside much of July 25, the Feast of Saint James, as our own Day of Recollection for prayer and planning for the upcoming parish calendar year. We have determined to go off site and to begin with face time with Jesus at the Poor Clare Monastery on Rocky River Drive – holy ground favored by both of us. Be assured we will lift you up in prayer and we ask that you do the same for us come Thursday.**
