The Church of Saint Clare Parishioners

For parishioners with an Individual Retirement
 Account (IRA) requiring an annual minimum
 distribution (RMD), you can reduce your tax
 liability and assist the Church of Saint Clare at the
 same time.

You can instruct your financial advisor or
 depository to withdraw your annual contribution to
 the Church of Saint Clare from your IRA
 account. The amount that is sent will be tax free up
 to the RMD amount. This can be done
 quarterly or annually. Funds must be sent directly
 to the Church of Saint Clare to qualify for a
 tax-free status.

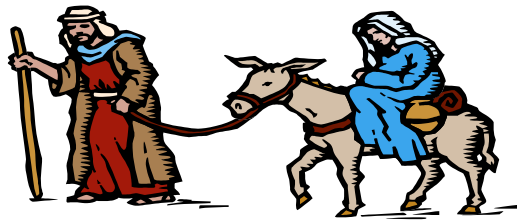
