



St. Clare Parish Financial Highlights – Fiscal Year ended June 30, 2021

- ➤ In spite of a global pandemic, due to the generosity of our faithful St. Clare parishioners coupled with the prudent management and control of expenses, this past fiscal year resulted in a surplus of \$175,000.
- ➤ A significant portion of this surplus is also attributable to the forgiveness of a \$102,000 Government Loan that St. Clare applied for as part of the Payroll Protection Program that allowed us to maintain full employment of our dedicated parish employees.
- ➤ Offertory and Capital Improvement revenues were sustained at levels consistent with pre-Covid collections, partially attributable to increased use of Online Giving as well as continued consistent planful giving.
- Expenses such as utilities and maintenance were down due to fewer parishioners "in pew" during the height of Covid and thanks to the Live Streaming, provided at no cost by one of our loyal parishioners, that allowed our parishioners to stay connected during this remote period.
- Lastly, supporting Corpus Christi Academy is an integral part of our parish mission to provide Catholic Education to our youth. Although a significant line item in the budget each year, we plan for this and have been within budget to date.


