FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Bishop Malesic has published POST PANDEMIC PROTOCOL INSTRUCTIONS which go into effect on June 2, 2021. You can find the complete three page document on our diocesan and parish websites. What follows is a brief summary of what to expect at Mass next weekend.

Face Masks

The decision to wear or not to wear a mask at church is left to the individual. We are asked to make a prudent decision and to be respectful of the decisions made by our fellow parishioners.

Holy Water Fonts

The fonts will be filled with water blessed for Baptisms as is custom.

Pews

The use of all pews is now permitted. We are blessed to have a church seating capacity that comfortably accommodates our worshipping family.

Hymnals

You will find a new hymnal in the pew racks. BREAKING BREAD 2021 is a handsome and popular paperback hymnal. BREAKING BREAD is an annual subscription replaced each year on the First Sunday of Advent.

Offertory Collection and Gift Procession

Our ushers will resume the in-pew offertory collection. There will be no collection boxes at the doors. I choose not to resume the gift procession at this time.

Communion Rite

There will be no change in our exchange of the Sign of Peace. We seem comfortable! The Communion Processional remains the same utilizing four ministers. The distribution of the Precious Blood remains suspended.

10:00AM Live Stream

Live Stream concludes with Mass on June 6. We are all indebted to Eric and Rebecca Simna. They have been the most generous and faithful of volunteers throughout this pandemic. I hope our homebound can take advantage of the Cathedral live stream and EWTN recordings among others.

May the Lord Jesus bless and keep us on this Solemnity of His Body and Blood.

Decree

In the Name of the Lord. Amen.

Whereas on 3 April 2020 the Reverend Donald Oleksiak, diocesan administrator of the Diocese of Cleveland, *sede vacante*, granted a dispensation to the faithful of the Diocese of Cleveland from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation until 3 May 2020 (protocol number 255/2020) due to the danger of contagion of the Covid-19 virus and later extended indefinitely; and

Whereas the danger of contagion has been recognized at this time by civil authorities and medical experts to have diminished within the State of Ohio; and

Whereas the Metropolitan Archbishop of Cincinnati together in meeting on 13 May 2021 with the suffragan bishops of the Ecclesiastical Province of Cincinnati stated agreement to rescind in their respective archdiocese and dioceses the dispensation from the obligation of attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligations due to the danger posed by the spread of the Covid-19 virus.

I therefore with joy and gratitude to Almighty God hereby announce that the time has come for Catholics to return to the celebration of the Eucharist on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation.

The dispensation, no longer necessary, is hereby rescinded and the faithful of the Diocese of Cleveland are advised that they are morally obligated to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation (canons 898, 1247 CIC) beginning on the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of the Lord, 6 June 2021.

As has always been the case, if individuals are homebound, are frail due to illness or age or, in their well-formed consciences believe that going into public places – including Sunday worship at Mass – would place their health or the health of their loved ones in serious jeopardy, they are not bound by the obligation to attend Mass.

The faithful who are unable to attend Mass are nevertheless urged to make holy the Lord's Day. They are encouraged to pray, read the Scriptures, and take part in acts of charity, and if appropriate, view or listen to the celebration of the Eucharist made available by electronic technology. However, the viewing or listening of a broadcast Sunday Mass through various media, while spiritually beneficial, is not a substitute for attending Mass in person and does not fulfill the obligation. Questions regarding this matter may be directed to the pastor of the local parish.

Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." Matthew 28:19-20

Of all the great feasts we celebrate within the Church throughout the year, today's Solemnity presents us with a Mystery that is so deep and transcendent that our eternity will be spent in perpetual contemplation. The Trinity, the life of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, will never get old, never be fully understood, and will be the cause of our everlasting adoration and joy. Though the Church has used philosophical concepts to explain the Trinity, no human concept or description will ever fully explain who God is. Though we can point to some general truths about God, we will never be able to fully depict the inner essence, depth, beauty and omnipotence of the Trinity.

As we consider that fact, it's important to understand that the Trinity is not *first* a theological mystery we try to define. Rather, the Trinity is *first* a communion of Persons we are invited to know. We do not primarily come to know God through intellectual deduction. We come to know God through prayerful union with Him. Though theology is exceptionally useful and important, the essence of God is beyond any and every philosophical concept we can define.

The Father, Son and Holy Spirit are Persons. And as Persons, they want to be known. And they want to be known primarily through a life of deep and intimate prayer. Praying to One Person, of course, is praying to all, since they are One God. But we are, nonetheless, called to a relationship of love with the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. And though our feeble minds may not be able to fully comprehend the essence of God, He will draw us deeper and deeper into a knowledge of Him if we let Him.

Prayer often begins by saying prayers, by meditating upon Scripture, and by listening. But true prayer is something much deeper. True prayer is contemplative prayer that ultimately leads to divine union. Only God can initiate this form of prayer in our lives, and only God, through this deep form of prayer, can communicate Himself to us as He is. Some of the greatest mystics of our Church, such as Saint John of the Cross and Saint Teresa of Ávila, explain in their mystical theology that the deepest knowledge of God does not come through concepts or images. In fact, if we wish to obtain a knowledge of God in His essence, we must allow Him to purge every concept of Who He is so that the pure light of His essence can be poured forth upon our minds. This knowledge, they say, is beyond knowing "about" God. It's the beginning of a knowledge "of" God.

Reflect, today, upon the Most Holy Trinity. As you do, say a prayer to God asking for a deeper and more intimate knowledge of Him. Ask Him to communicate to you His divine love and to open your mind and heart to a deeper understanding of who He is. Try to humble yourself before the great Mystery of the inner life of God. Humility before the Mystery of God means that we know how little we know about Him and how little we know of Him. But that humble truth will help you move closer to the deeper relationship of love to which you are called.

Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, please draw me into a relationship of love with You who are one God and three divine Persons. May the mystery and beauty of Your life become more known and loved by me each day through the gift of transforming mystical prayer. Jesus, I trust in You.



The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

Dt 4:32-34, 39-40 | Rom 8:14-17 | Mt 28:16-20



The first thing that came to mind when hearing the readings for this feast was the song, How Can I Keep from Singing? Moses' words attest to the wonders of God and his continual care and "championing" for us. This all-powerful God chose us to be his own; he created us in love and desires for us to be with him forever. He loves us enough to have become one of us - to live and breathe and suffer as one of us! While on earth as Jesus Christ, he showed us, in healing and forgiving, the depth of his merciful and unconditional love. Through the Son we are made adopted children of God, co-heirs with Christ to the promises of the Kingdom. The Holy Spirit is sent to remain with us - always - demonstrating the steadfastness and faithfulness of God to his people and drawing others to the Father's love. And we, members of the Body of Christ, are commissioned to go "and make disciples of all nations," that all may be given the pathway to the Kingdom. With all this Good News, how can we keep from singing?

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

"When they all saw him, they worshiped, but they doubted." These words jumped out at me from today's Gospel. After all the Apostles had witnessed, even after their encounters with Jesus following his resurrection, they doubted. That is, until Jesus reassured them that "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me." Then, look out! Once empowered by the Spirit, the disciples no longer doubt. In readings from the Acts of the Apostles throughout the Easter season, we have heard how the Apostles are transformed into bold and relentless preachers and leaders, healers and miracle workers, by their belief in the power of the Holy Spirit. And they can't suppress the joy they know in believing the Good News. We were made for this joy, and for sharing it as the earliest disciples did. Given all that God has done for us, how can we not?

STUDY Read Scripture verses or hymns that rejoice in God's love and bring you joy (Phil 4:4-9 is a good start). Pray the Act of Faith to reaffirm your belief in the Trinity. Be a joyful Christian!
