

ORDINANCE NO. 2798

**AN ORDINANCE TO RETURN ADVANCES TO THE
GENERAL FUND FROM VARIOUS OTHER FUNDS
FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES
OF THE VILLAGE OF SHEFFIELD FOR 2021
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, it becomes necessary to return temporarily advanced funds into the general fund from various other funds to meet current expenditures.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SHEFFIELD, IN THE COUNTY OF LORAIN, AND THE STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The advances to the various other funds be returned to the general fund as follows:

FUND	AMOUNT
216 Solid Waste	\$ 8,325.80
220 Fire Levy	\$242,617.14

Section 2. It is found and determined that formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberation of this Council that resulted in such formal action occurred in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance be, and hereby is declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to provide adequate money for the public health, peace and welfare of the Village of Sheffield, Ohio, wherefore this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and upon its adoption and approval.
