Facts about Ukraine you need to know!

The world's longest wind instrument is the Ukrainian trembita. The Guinness Book of Records lists it. Trembita is a wooden trumpet that ranges in length from 2.5 to 8 metres and has a diameter of roughly 30 mm, and was used as a means of communication to notify events like the start and conclusion of the workday, childbirth, marriage, impending danger and more.
