Interesting Facts about Ukraine!

Wedding Bands are worn on their right hand. Ukrainians deemed that it was "unclean" to use the left hand, hence it wasn't appropriate to wear a representation of unending love. The right hand, on the other hand, was revered by the ancestors as a sign of strength, wisdom and good change. During the wedding ceremony, the wedding band was placed on it. In Ukraine, the wedding band on the left hand frequently deceives people. If one of the spouses has passed away, it is typically placed here on the other hand.
