St. Peter's people, beginning July 5th you have two worship options: Drive-in Worship in St. Peter's parking lot, and Zoom Worship. How will drive-in worship work?

- Attendees should enter the Church parking lot from the Elyria Avenue entrance no later than 9:50 a.m.
- Upon entrance each car will receive a bulletin and be directed forward.
- The next person they encounter will direct them to a parking place.
- Once parked, windows of the car may remain up or be put down during the service. Attendees are requested to stay in their cars during the service. (The audio of the service will be accessible on your car radio.)
- On communion Sunday, worshipers should bring their own bread and wine or grape juice.
- At the time of offertory, an usher will carry a basket around to each car to collect the offering. The congregation will sing the Doxology and the Pastor will bless the offering.
- Upon conclusion of the service, cars may exit through the two exits on Church Street.
