Schedule a meeting with St. Peter's minister.

You and Pastor will:

- check the availability of the date for your wedding at St. Peters, and Pastor's availability.
- calendar pre-wedding conversations.
- orient to the sanctuary or chapel and other space you will use on your wedding day.
- review wedding fees and guidelines
- review contact information for Wedding Coordinator and Organist
- agree upon Pastor's compensation / honorarium **

St. Peter's minister is responsible for conducting worship services and shall customarily be the officiating minister at all weddings. Additional ministers may play an assisting role in consultation with the St. Peter's minister. No wedding will be officially scheduled until the minister has spoken with the couple, confirmed calendar availability, and agreed to officiate at the service.

St. Peter's Wedding Coordinator_helps you with details specific to the wedding worship service. They open and close the building the day of the rehearsal and service. They orient the florist / photographer / other support persons. They assist the minister during rehearsal and worship at the minister's direction, including helping the principles of the wedding party to their proper places at the proper times; they help with general advice concerning building and sanctuary use specific to St. Peter's.

Photographer / Videographer / Sound equipment

The Pastor will review guidelines and expectations well ahead of the service. The Coordinator will help orient these professionals the day of the wedding.

Gathering Space

The minister will orient you on your initial visit. Groom and attendants: Upstairs in the Fireside Room. Bride and attendants: Downstairs in Fellowship Hall. Receiving line: inside or outside. "Bubbles" in lieu of birdseed, rice, etc.
