Welcome to St. Peter's U.C.C. Preschool! You are invited to meet your child's teacher at Parent Orientation Night on Monday, August 19th: 2-day classes (a.m. & p.m.) 5:00-5:30. \*\*This meeting is for parents only. \*\*

This is a good time for you to get acquainted with your child's teacher. Please bring to the Parent Night your child's medical/enrollment forms (enclosed/returning parents need to initial previous forms and fill out a new Walking Field Trip/Facebook Form) and their first and last month's tuition or payment in full (for payment in full: 2-Day a.m.-\$900.00 / 2-Day p.m.-\$810.00), and a wallet size picture of your child. There is also the annual special activity fee of \$35.00. This is for your child's Weekly Reader, Field Trip Fees, and special quest fees. This amount is payable to St. Peter's U.C.C. Preschool at Parent Night on August 19th along with tuition payments for September and May. If you are not available to come to the school at this time, please mail your medical/enrollment forms and September and May tuition payments and the \$35.00 yearly charge before September 1st.

Ohio state law requires that the Medical Statement Form, Enrollment & Health Form must be filled out and returned or your child will not be permitted to attend school until these forms are completed. The Enrollment & Health Form (both sides) are to be filled out by you. The Medical Statement Form is to be signed by your child's doctor and the child's physical & shot record must be current and up-to-date. The Ohio Department of Health requires the following immunizations for children attending preschool.

- Four doses of DtaP, DTP, DT, in any combination
- Three doses of OPV or IPV
- One dose of measles, mumps and rubella (MMR) vaccine
- Three or four doses of haemophilus b vaccine
- Three doses of hepatitis B vaccine

At Parent Night a Preschool Handbook will be given to each parent. This is a great time to speak to your child's teacher about any concerns or questions you may have.

\*\*Bring your child to meet their teacher and see the classroom at Children's Open House on: Tuesday, August 27<sup>th</sup>: Morning classes - 4:30-5:30 p.m. / Afternoon classes 5:30-6:30 p.m.\*\*

The first week of school, there will be a 1 1/2-hour orientation for the children only. Parents are welcome to stay in the Fellowship Hall. The Tuesday-Thursday morning session will be on Tuesday, September 3rd from 9:00-10:30 A.M. Regular class hours will start on *Thursday*, *September 5*<sup>th</sup>. Morning class hours are 9:00-12:00 P.M.

The Tuesday-Thursday afternoon session will be on Tuesday, September 3<sup>rd</sup> from 12:45-2:15 A.M.

Regular class hours will start on *Thursday*, *September*  $5^{th}$ . Afternoon class hours are 12:45-3:15 P.M.

Please make your tuition checks payable to St. Peter's U.C.C. Preschool. We ask your cooperation in making sure your monthly

payment of \$100.00/\$90.00 is received by the 10th of each month. Please deposit your tuition in the drop off box for your convenience. A late fee of \$10.00 will be charged if payment is not received by the 10th of each month.

Preschool is a time for your child to prepare for a lifetime of outside-the-home learning and a time for developing good attitudes regarding learning in school. He or she will have the opportunity to meet and associate with others of the same age and learn to adjust to a routine and to develop good work habits.
