Try this at home... Bead Ornaments

Needed: 1.) Beads 2.) Pipe cleaners

For a wreath, string green beads onto the pipe cleaner and add a red bead after every 4-6 green beads. Then shape it into a circle. Use these ornaments to decorate the tree or to attach to a wreath.
